## **General description**

The assessed route runs from Valiano to Cortona.

It mainly goes along flat country roads, reaching the base of the hill on which Cortona is located and this is the part of the route that climbs with more significant slopes.

The conditions of the pathway do not pose a particular problem, except for some difficult points due to the surface conditions; the final climb towards Cortona is challenging but on the suitable ground surface.

Along the way there are both cultural sites (especially ecclesiastical buildings) and accommodation facilities (open mainly in the spring/summer period).

The conditions of the path make it partially accessible even to people with mobility issues who can still walk independently and to people with visual disabilities (total or partial), if accompanied. There is a lack of equipped rest areas and there are no water supply points.
